- The admission score is the written examination (multiple choice) grade in Mathematics or Informatics, according to the candidate's choice upon application, amounting to 100% of the final grade.

## SELECTION CRITERIA FOR ALL SPECIALISATIONS

- High school graduates holding a baccalaureate diploma will sit a written examination and the admission score will be calculated according to the following algorithm:

$$\text{ADMISSION SCORE} = 0.5 \times \text{BACCALAUREATE SCORE}^* + 0.5 \times \text{WRITTEN TEST SCORE}$$

\* For the BACCALAUREATE SCORE the candidate can opt for one of the following: BACCALAUREATE AVERAGE SCORE or the BACCALAUREATE EXAM GRADE in PHYSICS, INFORMATICS, MATHEMATICS.

- The Faculty of Physics acknowledges the Augustin Maior Physics Competition, school Olympiads and a series of competitions for the high school students as an alternative admission method (details in the Faculty of Physics Addendum to the Regulation for organizing and conducting undergraduate level admission examination).

- Multiple choice test worth 20% of the admission score, upon choice between:
  - Inorganic Chemistry
  - Organic Chemistry
  - Mathematics - Algebra

- Baccalaureate exam score worth 80% of the admission score.

ADMISSION SCORE = 0.2 X ADMISSION TEST GRADE + 0.8 X BACCALAUREATE SCORE

- At the request of the candidate, the grade obtained in the Candin Liteanu competition can replace the admission score.

ADMISSION SCORE =  $0.7 \times \text{COMPETITION GRADE} + 0.3 \times \text{BACCALAUREATE SCORE}$

- For applicants who have received awards or special prizes at recognised international and national school Olympiads endorsed by the Ministry, the admission score is 10.00, based on the supporting documentation.

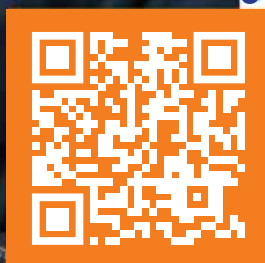

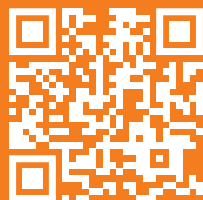

### Pedagogical Module (Level I - first phase)

The first phase of training consists of two primary components:

- psycho-pedagogical, didactic, and practical training provided by DPPD
- specialised training provided by the faculties

One must complete the two components of training in order to become a teacher (psycho-pedagogical, didactic, practical and specialised training).

Successful completion of the psycho-pedagogical training programme Level I entitles you to work as a teacher in mandatory pre-university education, based on the specialisation obtained through the bachelor's degree.

Admission to the Level I psycho-pedagogical training programme will be made exclusively online upon confirmation of place at the faculty.

A motivation essay written in the language of instruction of the Pedagogical module (Romanian, Hungarian or German) is required for admission to the psycho-pedagogical training programme Level I.

Candidates enrolled in an undergraduate programme on a state-funded place will benefit of state funding to study the Pedagogical module courses.

Candidates enrolled in an undergraduate programme on a tuition-paying basis will study the Pedagogical module courses on tuition.
