Applications for the Level II (second phase) of psycho-pedagogical (further training) programme will be submitted exclusively online upon confirmation of place at master's degree programme. Successful completion of the psycho-pedagogical training programme Level II entitles you to work as a teacher at any level of education, based on the specialisation obtained through the bachelor's degree.

Only Level I graduates who are first-year master's students can apply for Level II of the psycho-pedagogical training programme.

Documents required for applications:

- copy of DPPD Level I graduation certification or certificate, with addendum
- copy of graduation certification or graduation diploma, with diploma supplement/ academic transcript
