*The specialisation test includes a three-hour written exam, covering the topics of the undergraduate final examination for the field of mathematics and computer science, respectively.

- Candidates admitted to the master's degree on tuition will be required to pay a fee in order to pursue the courses in the pedagogical module.

They will pay the first instalment, i.e. the fee for the first semester of the academic year 2025-2026, in October.
